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Structured interview responses -using the CAMP / BARER / SPIES mnemonics

It can be helpful to practise using these three acronyms to create more structured responses to different types of interview questions.

<u>CAMPStructured Answer–For background and motivation questions about WHY</u> you have applied?

You might be asked, for example:

- Can you talk us through your CV?
- What makes you think you are fit to become a consultant?
- Tell us why you want to join this trust.

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SPIES Structured Answer- For questions on difficult colleagues or ethical issues

Questions might look something like this:

- You overhear a nurse talk about a registrar who was taking cocaine in a nightclub the previous weekend. How do you address the situation?
- One of your juniors keeps contradicting you in front of patients. What do you do?
